- Scores from before 01/01/2014 have EXPIRED.
- Computer based test
- Total testing time is 7 hours
  - Reasoning Through Language Arts test is 150 minutes
  - Mathematical Reasoning test is 115 minutes
  - Social Studies test is 70 minutes
  - Science test is 90 minutes

### Age Restrictions:

You must be 19 in the state of Minnesota to take the GED Tests. If you are under 19 you can apply for an age waiver. Talk to Albert Lea Adult Basic Education for more information.

### Cost:

Each GED test costs \$30.00 in the state of Minnesota. You must register and pay online ([ged.com](http://ged.com)). You may pay for tests one at a time. The total cost for all four tests is \$120.00. GED Practice Tests can be taken online for \$6.00 per subject.

### Testing Sites:

The official GED Test will be administered at a GED Testing Facility of your choosing. To find the nearest testing facility visit [GED.com](http://GED.com). Albert Lea Adult Basic Education is a registered Pearson Vue Testing Center! Look for Albert Lea when you register!

### Test Scoring:

The GED® test will have a passing score of 150 on each test part. Therefore, you will need to reach a score of at least 150 on each part and a total score of 600 across the four-part battery in order to receive your GED® test credential.

- Below Passing: 100 – 144
- Passing Score: 145 – 200
