Wireless HotSpot Parental Consent Form

Albert Lea High School is offering a limited number of free wireless hotspot devices to students who do not have internet access at home. This program enables students to “checkout” internet access for up to 7 days at a time – free of charge.

To ensure peace of mind, the devices use internet content filtering and are scheduled so that they cannot be used between 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. These hotspots will only work with our district-issued Chromebooks. The borrowing limit is one per household, but devices can be signed out repeatedly during the school year.

The parent/guardian must complete this form prior to each time a device is signed out to the student, unless a yearlong waiver is agreed to at the bottom of this form. By signing this form, the parent/guardian agrees to assume all responsibility for the equipment signed out to the student. A replacement fee of \$60 will be charged if the device is lost, damaged, or not returned.
